Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution;
which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 2703) to
combat terrorism.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2703) to combat terrorism. The
6 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General
7 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
8 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman

1 and ranking minority member of the Committee on the
2 Judiciary. After general debate the Committee of the
3 Whole shall rise without motion. No further consideration
4 of the bill shall be in order except pursuant to a subse-
5 quent order of the House.
