RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill (H.R. 1833) to amend title 18, United States Code, to ban partial-birth abortions.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 1833) to amend title 18, United States Code, to
4 ban partial-birth abortions, with Senate amendments
5 thereto, and to consider in the House a single motion to
6 concur in each of the Senate amendments. The Senate
7 amendments and the motion shall be considered as read.

1 The motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided
2 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
3 member of the Committee on the Judiciary. The previous
4 question shall be considered as ordered on the motion to
5 final adoption without intervening motion or demand for
6 division of the question.
