Ms. GREENE of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3322) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1997 for civilian science activities of the Federal Government, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3322) to authorize appropriations

1 for fiscal year 1997 for civilian science activities of the
2 Federal Government, and for other purposes. The first
3 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order
4 against consideration of the bill for failure to comply with
5 clause 2(1)(2) of rule XI are waived. General debate shall
6 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
7 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
8 nority member of the Committee on Science. After general
9 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under
10 the five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered by title
11 rather than by section. The first section and each title
12 shall be considered as read. Points of order against provi-
13 sions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 5(a) of
14 rule XXI are waived. Before consideration of any other
15 amendment it shall be in order to consider the amendment
16 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
17 panying this resolution, if offered by Representative Walk-
18 er of Pennsylvania or his designee. That amendment shall
19 be considered as read, may amend portions of the bill not
20 yet read for amendment, shall be debatable for ten min-
21 utes equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
22 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
23 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
24 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. If that
25 amendment is adopted, the bill, as amended, shall be con-

1 sidered as the original bill for the purpose of further
2 amendment. During further consideration of the bill for
3 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole
4 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether
5 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be
6 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-
7 ignated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amend-
8 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-
9 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
10 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
11 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
12 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
13 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
14 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
15 structions.
