4 of the Treasury. All points of order against the bill and
5 against its consideration are waived. The amendment
6 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
7 panying this resolution shall be considered as adopted.
8 The bill, as amended, shall be debatable for one hour
9 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
10 ing minority member of the Committee on Ways and
11 Means. The previous question shall be considered as or-
12 dered on the bill, as amended, to final passage without
13 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
14 or without instructions.
