Mr. QUILLEN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3517) making appropriations for military construction, family housing, and base realignment and closure for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3517) making appropriations for

1 military construction, family housing, and base realign-
2 ment and closure for the Department of Defense for the
3 fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, and for other pur-
4 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
5 Points of order against consideration of the bill for failure
6 to comply with clause 7 of rule XXI are waived. General
7 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
8 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
9 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-
10 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered
11 for amendment under the five minute rule. Points of order
12 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
13 clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived. During consideration
14 of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee
15 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
16 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has
17 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
18 Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule
19 XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as
20 read. The Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may
21 postpone until a time during further consideration in the
22 Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on
23 any amendment. The Chairman of the Committee of the
24 Whole may reduce to not less than five minutes the time
25 for voting by electronic device on any postponed question

1 that immediately follows another vote by electronic device
2 without intervening business, provided that the time for
3 voting by electronic device on the first in any series of
4 questions shall be not less than fifteen minutes. After the
5 reading of the final lines of the bill, a motion that the
6 Committee of the Whole rise and report the bill to the
7 House with such amendments as may have been adopted
8 shall, if offered by the majority leader or a designee, have
9 precedence over a motion to amend. At the conclusion of
10 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
11 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
12 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
13 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
14 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
15 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
16 structions.
