

H. Res. 448

In the House of Representatives, U.S.,

June 12, 1996.

1 *Resolved,* That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2754) to approve and implement
6 the OECD Shipbuilding Trade Agreement. The first read-
7 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
8 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-
9 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
10 hour equally divided among and controlled by the chair-
11 men and ranking minority members of the Committee on
12 Ways and Means and the Committee on National Security.
13 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
14 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order
15 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
16 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-
17 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
18 Ways and Means now printed in the bill, modified by the

1 amendment printed in part 1 of the report of the Commit-
2 tee on Rules accompanying this resolution. That amend-
3 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as
4 read. All points of order against that amendment in the
5 nature of a substitute are waived. No other amendment
6 shall be in order except the amendment printed in part
7 2 of the report of the Committee on Rules. That amend-
8 ment may be offered only by a Member designated in the
9 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
10 one hour equally divided and controlled by the proponent
11 and an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and
12 shall not be subject to a demand for division of the ques-
13 tion in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All
14 points of order against that amendment are waived. At
15 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment
16 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House
17 with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any
18 Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any
19 amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the
20 bill or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute
21 made in order as original text. The previous question shall
22 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments

- 1 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
- 2 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
