Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 2275) to reauthorize and amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

Mr. BONILLA (for himself and Mr. CONDIT) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 2275) to reauthorize and amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution, the House shall resolve itself into the Commit-
3 tee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for the
4 consideration of the bill (H.R. 2275) to reauthorize and
5 amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973. The first
6 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
7 order against the bill and against its consideration are
8 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
9 shall not exceed two hours, with one hour to be equally
10 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-

1 nority member of the Committee on Resources, and with
2 one hour to be equally divided and controlled by the chair-
3 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
4 Agriculture. After general debate, the bill shall be consid-
5 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule and shall
6 be considered as read. No amendment shall be in order
7 except an amendment to be offered by Representative
8 Young of Alaska, Mr. Roberts of Kansas, Mr. Miller of
9 California, and Mr. de la Garza of Texas. Each amend-
10 ment may be offered only by the named proponent or a
11 designee, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable
12 for one hour equally divided and controlled by the pro-
13 ponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to
14 amendment. No amendment shall remain in order after
15 the adoption of a previous amendment in the nature of
16 a substitute. If on any day the Committee of the Whole
17 rises and reports that it has come to no resolution on the
18 bill, then on the next legislative day the House shall, im-
19 mediately after the third daily order of business under
20 clause 1 of rule XXIV, resolve into the Committee of the
21 Whole for further consideration of the bill. At the conclu-
22 sion of consideration of the bill for amendment the Com-
23 mittee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
24 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
25 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and

- 1 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
- 2 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
- 3 structions.
