Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3754) making appropriations for the Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3754) making appropriations for
6 the Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending Septem-
7 ber 30, 1997, and for other purposes. The first reading

1 of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order against
2 consideration of the bill for failure to comply with clause
3 2(l)(6) of rule XI, clause 7 of rule XXI, or section 302
4 or 308 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are
5 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
6 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
7 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
8 Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the
9 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
10 minute rule and shall be considered as read. Points of
11 order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply
12 with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived. No amendment
13 shall be in order except those printed in the report of the
14 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each
15 amendment may be considered only in the order printed
16 in the report, may be offered only by a member designated
17 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
18 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
19 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
20 not be subject to amendment except as specified in the
21 report, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
22 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
23 Whole. All points of order against amendments printed in
24 the report are waived. The Chairman of the Committee
25 of the Whole may postpone until a time during further

1 consideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for
2 a recorded vote on any amendment. The Chairman of the
3 Committee of the Whole may reduce to not less than five
4 minutes the time for voting by electronic device on any
5 postponed question that immediately follows another vote
6 by electronic device without intervening business, provided
7 that the time for voting by electronic device on the first
8 in any series of questions shall be not less than 15 min-
9 utes. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
10 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
11 to the House with such amendments as may have been
12 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
13 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
14 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
15 with or without instructions.
