## RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 101) to transfer a parcel of land to the Taos Pueblo Indians of New Mexico.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 101) to transfer a parcel of land  
6 to the Taos Pueblo Indians of New Mexico. The first read-  
7 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall

1 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-  
2 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
3 nority member of the Committee on Resources. After gen-  
4 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment  
5 under the five-minute rule. Each section shall be consid-  
6 ered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill  
7 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the  
8 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been  
9 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as  
10 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-  
11 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-  
12 commit.
