Mr. QUILLEN, from the Committee on Rules reported the following resolution
which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 667) to
control crime by incarcerating violent criminals.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 667) to control crime by incarcerat-
6 ing violent criminals. The first reading of the bill shall
7 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-
8 ation of the bill for failure to comply with clause 2(l)(2)(B)

1 or clause 2(l)(6) of rule XI are waived. General debate
2 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour
3 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
4 ing minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary.
5 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
6 amendment under the five-minute rule for a period not
7 to exceed ten hours. It shall be in order to consider as
8 an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the
9 five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
10 stitute recommended by the Committee on the Judiciary
11 now printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the
12 nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. Points
13 of order against the committee amendment in the nature
14 of a substitute for failure to comply with clause 7 of rule
15 XVI or clause 5(a) of rule XXI are waived. During consid-
16 eration of the bill for amendment, the chairman of the
17 Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition
18 on the basis of whether the Member offering an amend-
19 ment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Con-
20 gressional Record designated for that purpose in clause
21 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be consid-
22 ered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
23 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
24 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
25 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the

1 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
2 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
3 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
4 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
5 to final passage without intervening motion except one
6 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
