Mr. HYDE submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Oversight

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts for the expenses of the Committee on the Judiciary in the One Hundred Fourth Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.**

3 For the expenses of the Committee on the Judiciary
4 (hereinafter in this resolution referred to as the “Commit-
5 tee”), including—

6 (1) the expenses of all staff salaries; and

7 (2) the expenses of staff training under section

8 202(j) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946

9 (2 U.S.C. 72a(j));

1 there shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts for com-
2 mittee salaries and expenses of the House of Representa-
3 tives, not more than \$9,683,190 for the One Hundred
4 Fourth Congress.

5 **SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.**

6 Of the amount specified in section 1—

7 (1) not more than \$4,672,187 shall be available
8 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
9 noon on January 3, 1995, and ending immediately
10 before noon on January 3, 1996; and

11 (2) not more than \$5,011,003 shall be available
12 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
13 noon on January 3, 1996, and ending immediately
14 before noon on January 3, 1997.

15 **SEC. 3. STAFF TRAINING.**

16 Of the amount specified—

17 (1) in paragraph (1) of section 2, not more
18 than \$8,000 may be used for staff training referred
19 to in section 1; and

20 (2) in paragraph (2) of section 2, not more
21 than \$10,000 may be used for staff training referred
22 to in section 1.

23 **SEC. 4. VOUCHERS.**

24 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
25 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the

1 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
2 directed by the Committee on House Oversight.

3 **SEC. 5. REGULATIONS.**

4 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
5 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
6 the Committee on House Oversight.
