Mr. SOLOMON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7) to revitalize the national security of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 7) to revitalize the national security
6 of the United States. The first reading of the bill shall
7 be dispensed with. General debate shall be confined to the
8 bill and the amendment in the nature of a substitute made

1 in order by this resolution and shall not exceed two hours
2 equally divided among and controlled by the chairmen and
3 ranking minority members of the Committee on Inter-
4 national Relations and the Committee on National Secu-
5 rity. After general debate the bill shall be considered for
6 amendment under the five-minute rule for a period not
7 to exceed ten hours. In lieu of the amendments rec-
8 ommended by the Committee on International Relations,
9 the Committee on National Security, and the Permanent
10 Select Committee on Intelligence, it shall be in order to
11 consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment
12 under the five-minute rule an amendment in the nature
13 of a substitute consisting of the text of H.R. 872. The
14 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-
15 ered as read. Points of order against the amendment in
16 the nature of a substitute for failure to comply with clause
17 (5)(a) of rule XXI are waived. During consideration of the
18 bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of
19 the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis
20 of whether the Member offering an amendment has caused
21 it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record
22 designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII.
23 Amendments so printed shall be considered as read. At
24 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment
25 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House

1 with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any
2 Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any
3 amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the
4 bill or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute
5 made in order as original text. The previous question shall
6 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
7 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
8 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
