Mr. THOMAS submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on House Oversight

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts for the expenses of the Committee on
House Oversight in the One Hundred Fourth Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.**

3 For the expenses of the Committee on House Over-
4 sight (hereinafter in this resolution referred to as the
5 “Committee”), including—

6 (1) the expenses of all staff salaries;

7 (2) the expenses of consultant services under
8 section 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act
9 of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 72a(i)); and

1 (3) the expenses of staff training under section
2 202(j) of such Act (2 U.S.C. 72a(j));
3 there shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the
4 House of Representatives for committee salaries and ex-
5 penses, not more than \$6,394,121 for the One Hundred
6 Fourth Congress.

7 **SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.**

8 Of the amount specified in section 1—

9 (1) not more than \$3,250,783 shall be available
10 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
11 noon on January 3, 1995, and ending immediately
12 before noon on January 3, 1996; and

13 (2) not more than \$3,143,338 shall be available
14 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
15 noon on January 3, 1996, and ending immediately
16 before noon on January 3, 1997.

17 **SEC. 3. CONSULTANT SERVICES AND STAFF TRAINING.**

18 Of the amount specified—

19 (1) in paragraph (1) of section 2, not more
20 than \$500,000 may be used for consultant services
21 referred to in section 1;

22 (2) in paragraph (2) of section 2, not more
23 than \$130,000 may be used for consultant services
24 referred to in section 1;

1 (3) in paragraph (1) of section 2, not more
2 than \$20,000 may be used for staff training referred
3 to in section 1; and

4 (4) in paragraph (2) of section 2, not more
5 than \$22,000 may be used for staff training referred
6 to in section 1.

7 **SEC. 4. VOUCHERS.**

8 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
9 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
10 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
11 directed by the Committee on House Oversight.

12 **SEC. 5. REGULATIONS.**

13 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
14 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
15 the Committee on House Oversight.
