## RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 830) to amend chapter 35 of title 44, United States Code, to further the goals of the Paperwork Reduction Act to have Federal agencies become more responsible and publicly accountable for reducing the burden of Federal paperwork on the public, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
- 3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 830) to amend chapter 35 of title  
3 44, United States Code, to further the goals of the Paper-  
4 work Reduction Act to have Federal agencies become more  
5 responsible and publicly accountable for reducing the bur-  
6 den of Federal paperwork on the public, and for other pur-  
7 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.  
8 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not  
9 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the  
10 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
11 on Government Reform and Oversight. After general de-  
12 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the  
13 five-minute rule. The bill and the amendments rec-  
14 ommended by the Committee on Government Reform and  
15 Oversight now printed in the bill shall be considered as  
16 read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
17 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill  
18 to the House with such amendments as may have been  
19 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
20 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
21 without intervening motion except one motion to recom-  
22 mit.
