CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Congress that a postage stamp
should be issued in honor of United States Masters
Swimming, Incorporated.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),* That it is the sense of the Congress that—

3 (1) a postage stamp should be issued in honor
4 of United States Masters Swimming, Incorporated;
5 and

6 (2) the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee
7 should recommend to the Postmaster General that
8 such a stamp be issued.
