## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol grounds for the SAFE  
KIDS Buckle Up Car Seat Safety Check.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2        *concurring),*

3        **SECTION 1. USE OF CAPITOL GROUNDS.**

4        The National SAFE KIDS Campaign (in this resolu-  
5        tion referred to as the “sponsor”) shall be permitted to  
6        sponsor a public event, the SAFE KIDS Buckle Up Car  
7        Seat Safety Check, on the Capitol grounds on August 27  
8        and 28, 1997, or on such other dates as the Speaker of  
9        the House of Representatives and the President pro tem-  
10       pore of the Senate may jointly designate.

1 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The event authorized to be con-  
3 ducted under section 1 shall be free of admission charge  
4 to the public and arranged not to interfere with the needs  
5 of Congress, under conditions to be prescribed by the Ar-  
6 chitect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police Board.

7 (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—The sponsor shall  
8 assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities  
9 incident to all activities associated with the event.

10 **SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

11 (a) STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT.—Subject to the  
12 approval of the Architect of the Capitol, the sponsor may  
13 erect upon the Capitol grounds such stage, sound amplifi-  
14 cation devices, and other related structures and equip-  
15 ment, and may take such other actions, as may be re-  
16 quired for the event authorized to be conducted under sec-  
17 tion 1.

18 (b) ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.—The Architect of  
19 the Capitol and the Capitol Police Board may make such  
20 additional arrangements as may be required to carry out  
21 the event.
