Mr. ARMEY introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Oversight

JOINT RESOLUTION

Waiving certain enrollment requirements with respect to certain specified bills of the One Hundred Fifth Congress.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the provisions of sections 106 and 107 of title 1,
4 United States Code, are waived for the balance of the first
5 session of the One Hundred Fifth Congress with respect
6 to the printing (on parchment or otherwise) of the enroll-
7 ment of any bill or joint resolution making general appro-
8 priations for the fiscal year ending on September 30,
9 1998, or continuing appropriations for the fiscal year end-
10 ing on September 30, 1998. The enrollment of any such

1 bill or joint resolution shall be in such form as the Com-
2 mittee on House Oversight of the House of Representa-
3 tives certifies to be a true enrollment.
