A BILL

For the relief of Global Exploration and Development Corporation, Kerr-McGee Corporation, and Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS AGAINST THE UNITED STATES.**
2

3 (a) **PAYMENT OF CLAIMS.**—The Secretary of the
4 Treasury shall pay, out of money not otherwise appropriated—
5

6 (1) to the Global Exploration and Development
7 Corporation, a Florida corporation incorporated in
8 Delaware, \$9,500,000;

9 (2) to Kerr-McGee Corporation, an Oklahoma
10 corporation incorporated in Delaware, \$10,000,000;
11 and

12 (3) to Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation, an
13 Oklahoma corporation incorporated in Delaware, \$0.

14 (b) **CONDITION OF PAYMENT.**—(1) The payment au-
15 thorized by subsection (a)(1) shall be in full satisfaction
16 of all claims of Global Exploration and Development Cor-
17 poration in connection with the failure of the United
18 States to grant or approve any lease or to allow phosphate
19 mining in the Osceola National Forest.

20 (2) The payments authorized by subsection (a)(2)
21 shall be in full satisfaction of all claims of Kerr-McGee
22 Corporation and Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation in
23 connection with the failure of the United States to grant
24 or approve any lease or to allow phosphate mining in the
25 Osceola National Forest.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FEES.**

2 No more than 15 percent of the sums authorized to
3 be paid by section 1 shall be paid to or received by any
4 agent or attorney for services rendered in connection with
5 the recovery of such sums. Any person violating this sec-
6 tion shall be fined not more than \$1,000.

7 **SECTION 1. SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS AGAINST THE**
8 **UNITED STATES.**

9 (a) *PAYMENT OF CLAIMS.*—*The Secretary of the Treas-*
10 *ury shall pay, out of money not otherwise appropriated—*

11 (1) *to the Global Exploration and Development*
12 *Corporation, a Florida corporation incorporated in*
13 *Delaware, \$9,500,000;*

14 (2) *to Kerr-McGee Corporation, an Oklahoma*
15 *corporation incorporated in Delaware, \$10,000,000;*
16 *and*

17 (3) *to Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation, an*
18 *Oklahoma corporation incorporated in Delaware, \$0.*

19 (b) *CONDITION OF PAYMENT.*—(1) *The payment au-*
20 *thorized by subsection (a)(1) is in settlement and com-*
21 *promise of all claims of Global Exploration and Develop-*
22 *ment Corporation, as described in the recommendations of*
23 *the Court of Federal Claims set forth in 36 Fed. Cl. 776.*

24 (2) *The payment authorized by subsections (a)(2) and*
25 *(a)(3) are in settlement and compromise of all claims of*
26 *Kerr-McGee Corporation and Kerr-McGee Chemical*

1 Corporation, as described in the recommendations of the
2 Court of Federal Claims set forth in 36 Fed. Cl. 776.

3 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FEES.**

4 No more than 15 percent of the sums authorized to be
5 paid by section 1 shall be paid to or received by any agent
6 or attorney for services rendered in connection with the re-
7 covery of such sums. Any person violating this section shall
8 be fined not more than \$1,000.
