Mr. Goss introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence

A BILL

To authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1998 for intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the United States Government, the Community Management Account, and the Central Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability System, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Intelligence Authoriza-
5 tion Act for Fiscal Year 1998”.

1 **TITLE I—INTELLIGENCE**
2 **ACTIVITIES**

3 **SEC. 101. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for
5 fiscal year 1998 for the conduct of the intelligence and
6 intelligence-related activities of the following elements of
7 the United States Government:

8 (1) The Central Intelligence Agency.

9 (2) The Department of Defense.

10 (3) The Defense Intelligence Agency.

11 (4) The National Security Agency.

12 (5) The Department of the Army, the Depart-
13 ment of the Navy, and the Department of the Air
14 Force.

15 (6) The Department of State.

16 (7) The Department of the Treasury.

17 (8) The Department of Energy.

18 (9) The Federal Bureau of Investigation.

19 (10) The Drug Enforcement Administration.

20 (11) The National Reconnaissance Office.

21 (12) The National Imagery and Mapping Agen-
22 cy.

23 **SEC. 102. CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AUTHORIZATIONS.**

24 (a) SPECIFICATIONS OF AMOUNTS AND PERSONNEL
25 CEILINGS.—The amounts authorized to be appropriated

1 under section 101, and the authorized personnel ceilings
2 as of September 30, 1998, for the conduct of the intel-
3 ligence and intelligence-related activities of the elements
4 listed in such section, are those specified in the classified
5 Schedule of Authorizations prepared to accompany the bill
6 H.R. _____ of the 105th Congress.

7 (b) AVAILABILITY OF CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AU-
8 THORIZATIONS.—The Schedule of Authorizations shall be
9 made available to the Committees on Appropriations of
10 the Senate and House of Representatives and to the Presi-
11 dent. The President shall provide for suitable distribution
12 of the Schedule, or of appropriate portions of the Sched-
13 ule, within the executive branch.

14 **SEC. 103. PERSONNEL CEILING ADJUSTMENTS.**

15 (a) AUTHORITY FOR ADJUSTMENTS.—With the ap-
16 proval of the Director of the Office of Management and
17 Budget, the Director of Central Intelligence may authorize
18 employment of civilian personnel in excess of the number
19 authorized for fiscal year 1998 under section 102 when
20 the Director of Central Intelligence determines that such
21 action is necessary to the performance of important intel-
22 ligence functions, except that the number of personnel em-
23 ployed in excess of the number authorized under such sec-
24 tion may not, for any element of the intelligence commu-

1 nity, exceed two percent of the number of civilian person-
2 nel authorized under such section for such element.

3 (b) NOTICE TO INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEES.—The
4 Director of Central Intelligence shall promptly notify the
5 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the House
6 of Representatives and the Select Committee on Intel-
7 ligence of the Senate whenever he exercises the authority
8 granted by this section.

9 **SEC. 104. COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT ACCOUNT.**

10 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
11 authorized to be appropriated for the Community Manage-
12 ment Account of the Director of Central Intelligence for
13 fiscal year 1998 the sum of \$. Within such
14 amount, funds identified in the classified Schedule of Au-
15 thorizations referred to in section 102(a) for the Advanced
16 Research and Development Committee and the Environ-
17 mental Intelligence and Applications Program shall re-
18 main available until September 30, 1999.

19 (b) AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL LEVELS.—The ele-
20 ments within the Community Management Account of the
21 Director of Central Intelligence are authorized a total of
22 full-time personnel as of September 30, 1998. Such
23 personnel may be permanent employees of the Community
24 Management Account elements or personnel detailed from
25 other elements of the United States Government.

1 (c) CLASSIFIED AUTHORIZATIONS.—In addition to
2 amounts authorized to be appropriated by subsection (a)
3 and the personnel authorized by subsection (b)—

4 (1) there is authorized to be appropriated for
5 fiscal year 1998 such amounts, and

6 (2) there is authorized such personnel as of
7 September 30, 1998,
8 for the Community Management Account as are specified
9 in the classified Schedule of Authorizations referred to in
10 section 102(a).

11 (d) REIMBURSEMENT.—During fiscal year 1998, any
12 officer or employee of the United States or a member of
13 the Armed Forces who is detailed to an element of the
14 Community Management Account from another element
15 of the United States Government shall be detailed on a
16 reimbursable basis, except that any such officer, employee,
17 or member may be detailed on a nonreimbursable basis
18 for a period of less than one year for the performance of
19 temporary functions as required by the Director of Central
20 Intelligence.

1 **TITLE II—CENTRAL INTEL-**
 2 **LIGENCE AGENCY RETIRE-**
 3 **MENT AND DISABILITY SYS-**
 4 **TEM**

5 **SEC. 201. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

6 There is authorized to be appropriated for the
 7 Central Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability
 8 Fund for fiscal year 1998 the sum of \$.

9 **TITLE III—GENERAL**
 10 **PROVISIONS**

11 **SEC. 301. INCREASE IN EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION AND**
 12 **BENEFITS AUTHORIZED BY LAW.**

13 Appropriations authorized by this Act for salary, pay,
 14 retirement, and other benefits for Federal employees may
 15 be increased by such additional or supplemental amounts
 16 as may be necessary for increases in such compensation
 17 or benefits authorized by law.

18 **SEC. 302. RESTRICTION ON CONDUCT OF INTELLIGENCE**
 19 **ACTIVITIES.**

20 The authorization of appropriations by this Act shall
 21 not be deemed to constitute authority for the conduct of
 22 any intelligence activity which is not otherwise authorized
 23 by the Constitution or the laws of the United States.

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
