## A BILL

To make a minor adjustment in the exterior boundary of the Devils Backbone Wilderness in the Mark Twain National Forest, Missouri, to exclude a small parcel of land containing improvements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT, DEVILS BACKBONE**  
4 **WILDERNESS, MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOR-**  
5 **EST, MISSOURI.**

6 The boundary of the Devils Backbone Wilderness es-  
7 tablished by section 201(d) of Public Law 96-560 (16

1 U.S.C. 1132 note) in the Mark Twain National Forest,  
2 Missouri, is hereby modified to exclude from the area en-  
3 compassed by the Devils Backbone Wilderness a parcel of  
4 real property consisting of approximately two acres in  
5 Ozark County, Missouri, and containing a garage, well,  
6 mailbox, driveway, and other improvements, as depicted  
7 on a map entitled “Devils Backbone Wilderness Boundary  
8 Modification”, dated June 1996. The map shall be re-  
9 tained with other Forest Service maps and legal descrip-  
10 tions regarding the Devils Backbone Wilderness and shall  
11 be made available for public inspection as provided in sec-  
12 tion 202 of Public Law 96–560 (94 Stat. 3274).
