AN ACT

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applica-
ble to the construction of FERC Project Number 9248
in the State of Colorado, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE AND REINSTATE-**
2 **MENT OF LICENSE.**

3 (a) **EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**—Notwithstanding
4 the time period specified in section 13 of the Federal
5 Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply
6 to Federal Energy Regulatory Commission project num-
7 bered 9248, the Commission shall, at the request of the
8 licensee for the project, and after reasonable notice, in ac-
9 cordance with the good faith, due diligence, and public in-
10 terest requirements of that section and the Commission’s
11 procedures under that section, extend the time required
12 for commencement of construction of the project until
13 January 30, 2002.

14 (b) **REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.**—The
15 Commission shall reinstate, effective as of the date of its
16 expiration, the license of the Town of Telluride, Colorado,
17 for the project referred to in subsection (a) that expired
18 prior to the date of the enactment of this Act.
