## A BILL

For the relief of Chong Ho Kwak.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATURALIZATION FOR CHONG HO KWAK.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—By reason the inability of Chong  
5 Ho Kwak to understand the oath of allegiance required  
6 under section 337(a) of the Immigration and Nationality  
7 Act, because of his physical disability, notwithstanding  
8 such section or any other provision of such Act, the Attor-  
9 ney General shall naturalize Chong Ho Kwak, residing at  
10 7 East Dulles Drive, Camp Hill, Pennsylvania, as a citizen  
11 of the United States, without his being administered the

1 oath of allegiance pursuant to such section, not later than  
2 5 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act shall take effect on  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act and shall apply re-  
5 gardless of whether the application for naturalization filed  
6 by Chong Ho Kwak before the date of the enactment of  
7 this Act has been finally denied by the Attorney General  
8 as of such date.
