AN ACT

For the relief of Chong Ho Kwak.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. NATURALIZATION FOR CHONG HO KWAK.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—By reason the inability of Chong
3 Ho Kwak to understand the oath of allegiance required
4 under section 337(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
5 Act, because of his physical disability, notwithstanding
6 such section or any other provision of such Act, the Attor-
7 ney General shall naturalize Chong Ho Kwak, residing at
8 7 East Dulles Drive, Camp Hill, Pennsylvania, as a citizen
9 of the United States, without his being administered the
10 oath of allegiance pursuant to such section, not later than
11 5 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act shall take effect on
13 the date of the enactment of this Act and shall apply re-
14 gardless of whether the application for naturalization filed
15 by Chong Ho Kwak before the date of the enactment of
16 this Act has been finally denied by the Attorney General
17 as of such date.
