**AN ACT**To extend the time required for the construction of a  
hydroelectric project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF PERIOD TO COMMENCE CON-**  
4 **STRUCTION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period  
6 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16  
7 U.S.C. 805) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-  
8 ergy Regulatory Commission Project numbered 10395, the

1 Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the  
2 project and after reasonable notice, in accordance with the  
3 good faith, due deference, and public interest requirements  
4 of that section and the Commission's procedures under  
5 that section, extend the time period during which the li-  
6 censee is required to commence the construction of the  
7 project, under the extension described in subsection (b),  
8 not more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect  
10 on the date of the expiration of the extension of the period  
11 required for commencement of construction of the project  
12 described in subsection (a) that the Commission issued,  
13 prior to the date of enactment of this Act, under section  
14 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806).
