A BILL

To amend the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 to modify the requirements for implementation of an entry-exit control system.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF ENTRY-EXIT CONTROL SYS-**

4 **TEM.**

5 Section 110 of the Illegal Immigration Reform and
6 Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a), in the matter preceding
2 paragraph (1), strike “Act,” and insert “Act (and
3 not later than 3 years after the date of the enact-
4 ment of this Act in the case of land border points
5 of entry),”;

6 (2) in subsection (a)(1), strike “and” at the
7 end;

8 (3) in subsection (a)(2), strike the period at the
9 end and insert “; and”;

10 (4) by adding at the end of subsection (a) the
11 following:

12 “(3) not significantly disrupt trade, tourism, or
13 other legitimate cross-border traffic at land border
14 points of entry.”.
