2002.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON NIO-**  
4 **BIUM OXIDE.**

5 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-  
6 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting  
7 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

3 spect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for
