A BILL

To amend the conservation reserve program to treat a nonprofit organization that rents land from a State (or a political subdivision or agency thereof) as a separate person for purposes of applying the limitation on payments under conservation reserve contracts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATIONS ON ANNUAL PAYMENTS UNDER**
4 **CONSERVATION RESERVE CONTRACTS.**

5 Section 1234(f) of the Food Security Act of 1985 (16
6 U.S.C. 3834(f)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing new paragraph:

1 “(5)(A) A nonprofit organization that rents land
2 from a State, political subdivision, or agency thereof and
3 enters into a contract under this subchapter with respect
4 to all or some portion of that land shall be treated as a
5 separate person for purposes of paragraph (1). Payments
6 made under such a contract shall not be counted toward
7 the payment limitation otherwise applicable to the State,
8 political subdivision, or agency thereof that is the lessor
9 of the land.

10 “(B) In this paragraph, the term ‘nonprofit organiza-
11 tion’ means an organization described in subsection (c) of
12 section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 that
13 is exempt from taxation under subsection (a) of such sec-
14 tion.”.

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
