Mr. CAMP introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend the Tariff Act of 1930 to allow the sale of certain gasoline, alternative motor fuels, and motor oil at duty-free sales enterprises.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SALE OF CERTAIN GASOLINE, ALTERNATIVE**
4 **MOTOR FUELS, AND MOTOR OIL AT DUTY-**
5 **FREE SALES ENTERPRISES UNDER THE TAR-**
6 **IFF ACT OF 1930.**

7 Section 555(b) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.
8 1555(b)) is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating paragraph (8) as para-
10 graph (9); and

1 (2) by inserting after paragraph (7) the follow-
2 ing:

3 “(8)(A) Gasoline, alternative motor fuels (in an
4 amount not to exceed 120 liters per vehicle), and
5 motor oil (in an amount not to exceed 6 liters per
6 vehicle), may be sold at a duty-free sales enterprise,
7 with all the benefits accruing to such sales, without
8 prior approval by the Customs Service.

9 “(B) The Customs Service may not prohibit the
10 sale of such merchandise unless the Secretary of the
11 Treasury determines that—

12 “(i) there is a pattern of re-importation of
13 the merchandise without declaration; and

14 “(ii) other means of preventing the re-im-
15 portation of the merchandise without declara-
16 tion are not available.”.
