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## A BILL

To authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1999 for intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the United States Government, the Community Management Account, and the Central Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability System, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Intelligence Authoriza-  
5 tion Act for Fiscal Year 1999”.

1                   **TITLE I—INTELLIGENCE**  
2                   **ACTIVITIES**

3 **SEC. 101. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4           Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for  
5 fiscal year 1999 for the conduct of the intelligence and  
6 intelligence-related activities of the following elements of  
7 the United States Government:

8                   (1) The Central Intelligence Agency.

9                   (2) The Department of Defense.

10                  (3) The Defense Intelligence Agency.

11                  (4) The National Security Agency.

12                  (5) The Department of the Army, the Depart-  
13                  ment of the Navy, and the Department of the Air  
14                  Force.

15                  (6) The Department of State.

16                  (7) The Department of the Treasury.

17                  (8) The Department of Energy.

18                  (9) The Federal Bureau of Investigation.

19                  (10) The Drug Enforcement Administration.

20                  (11) The National Reconnaissance Office.

21                  (12) The National Imagery and Mapping Agen-  
22                  cy.

23 **SEC. 102. CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AUTHORIZATIONS.**

24           (a) SPECIFICATIONS OF AMOUNTS AND PERSONNEL  
25 CEILINGS.—The amounts authorized to be appropriated

1 under section 101, and the authorized personnel ceilings  
2 as of September 30, 1999, for the conduct of the intel-  
3 ligence and intelligence-related activities of the elements  
4 listed in such section, are those specified in the classified  
5 Schedule of Authorizations prepared to accompany the bill  
6 H.R. \_\_\_\_ of the 105th Congress.

7 (b) AVAILABILITY OF CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AU-  
8 THORIZATIONS.—The Schedule of Authorizations shall be  
9 made available to the Committees on Appropriations of  
10 the Senate and House of Representatives and to the Presi-  
11 dent. The President shall provide for suitable distribution  
12 of the Schedule, or of appropriate portions of the Sched-  
13 ule, within the executive branch.

14 **SEC. 103. PERSONNEL CEILING ADJUSTMENTS.**

15 (a) AUTHORITY FOR ADJUSTMENTS.—With the ap-  
16 proval of the Director of the Office of Management and  
17 Budget, the Director of Central Intelligence may authorize  
18 employment of civilian personnel in excess of the number  
19 authorized for fiscal year 1999 under section 102 when  
20 the Director of Central Intelligence determines that such  
21 action is necessary to the performance of important intel-  
22 ligence functions, except that the number of personnel em-  
23 ployed in excess of the number authorized under such sec-  
24 tion may not, for any element of the intelligence commu-

1 nity, exceed two percent of the number of civilian person-  
2 nel authorized under such section for such element.

3 (b) NOTICE TO INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEES.—The  
4 Director of Central Intelligence shall promptly notify the  
5 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the House  
6 of Representatives and the Select Committee on Intel-  
7 ligence of the Senate whenever he exercises the authority  
8 granted by this section.

9 **SEC. 104. INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT AC-**  
10 **COUNT.**

11 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is  
12 authorized to be appropriated for the Intelligence Commu-  
13 nity Management Account of the Director of Central Intel-  
14 ligence for fiscal year 1999 the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_.  
15 Within such amount, funds identified in the classified  
16 Schedule of Authorizations referred to in section 102(a)  
17 for the Advanced Research and Development Committee  
18 shall remain available until September 30, 2000.

19 (b) AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL LEVELS.—The ele-  
20 ments within the Community Management Account of the  
21 Director of Central Intelligence is authorized \_\_\_\_ full-  
22 time personnel as of September 30, 1999. Personnel serv-  
23 ing in such elements may be permanent employees of the  
24 Community Management Staff or personnel detailed from  
25 other elements of the United States Government.

1 (c) REIMBURSEMENT.—Except as provided in section  
2 113 of the National Security Act of 1947, during fiscal  
3 year 1999, any officer or employee of the United States  
4 or a member of the Armed Forces who is detailed to the  
5 staff of the Community Management Account from an-  
6 other element of the United States Government shall be  
7 detailed on a reimbursable basis, except that any such offi-  
8 cer, employee or member may be detailed on a non-  
9 reimbursable basis for a period of less than one year for  
10 the performance of temporary functions as required by the  
11 Director of Central Intelligence.

12 **TITLE II—CENTRAL INTEL-**  
13 **LIGENCE AGENCY RETIRE-**  
14 **MENT AND DISABILITY SYS-**  
15 **TEM**

16 **SEC. 201. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

17 There is authorized to be appropriated for the Cen-  
18 tral Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability Fund  
19 for fiscal year 1999 the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_.

20 **TITLE III—GENERAL**  
21 **PROVISIONS**

22 **SEC. 301. INCREASE IN EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION AND**  
23 **BENEFITS AUTHORIZED BY LAW.**

24 Appropriations authorized by this Act for salary, pay,  
25 retirement, and other benefits for Federal employees may

1 be increased by such additional or supplemental amounts  
2 as may be necessary for increases in such compensation  
3 or benefits authorized by law.

4 **SEC. 302. RESTRICTION ON CONDUCT OF INTELLIGENCE**  
5 **ACTIVITIES.**

6 The authorization of appropriations by this Act shall  
7 not be deemed to constitute authority for the conduct of  
8 any intelligence activity which is not otherwise authorized  
9 by the Constitution or the laws of the United States.

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
