Mr. BILIRAKIS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Margarito Domantay.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SATISFACTION OF CLAIM AGAINST THE UNITED**
4 **STATES.**

5 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
6 funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Petty
7 Officer Margarito Domantay, United States Navy (re-
8 tired), of Tampa, Florida, the amount of retired pay that
9 he would have received for the period beginning on June
10 8, 1979, and ending on March 12, 1985, had he been ini-
11 tially retired in the grade of E-5, second class (rather

1 than the grade of E-4, third class, in which he was mis-
2 takenly retired due to administrative error).

3 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENT AND ATTORNEY FEES.**

4 It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-
5 cent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be paid
6 to, or received by, any agent or attorney for any service
7 rendered in connection with the claim described in such
8 section. Any person who violates this section shall be
9 guilty of an infraction, and shall be subject to a fine in
10 the amount provided in title 18, United States Code.
