A BILL

For the relief of John Wesley Davis.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATIONS.**

4 The time limitations set forth in section 3702(b) of
5 title 31, United States Code, shall not apply with respect
6 to a claim by John Wesley Davis, of Forestville, Maryland,
7 for the amounts due to him by the—

1 (1) Department of the Navy in the amount of
2 \$42,123.84; and

3 (2) Department of the Treasury in the amount
4 of \$12,508.20.

5 The amounts due are represented by checks that were re-
6 ceived but not negotiated by John Wesley Davis.

7 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE.**

8 Section 1 shall apply only if John Wesley Davis or
9 his authorized representative submits a claim pursuant to
10 such subsection before the expiration of the 6-month pe-
11 riod beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.

12 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATIONS.**

13 *The time limitations set forth in sections 3702(c) and*
14 *3328(a)(1) of title 31, United States Code, shall not apply*
15 *with respect to a claim by John Wesley Davis, of Forestville,*
16 *Maryland, for the amounts due to him by the—*

17 (1) *Department of the Navy in the amount of*
18 *\$42,123.84; and*

19 (2) *Department of the Treasury in the amount*
20 *of \$12,508.20.*

21 *The amounts due are represented by checks that were re-*
22 *ceived but not negotiated by John Wesley Davis.*

23 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE.**
