2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF TRINITY LAKE.**

2 (a) DESIGNATION.—The reservoir created by Trinity
3 Dam in the Central Valley project, California, and des-
4 ignated as “Clair Engle Lake” by Public Law 88–662 (78
5 Stat. 1093) is hereby redesignated as “Trinity Lake”.

6 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law, regula-
7 tion, document, record, map, or other paper of the United
8 States to the reservoir referred to in subsection (a) shall
9 be considered to be a reference to “Trinity Lake”.

10 (c) REPEAL OF EARLIER DESIGNATION.—Public
11 Law 88–662 (78 Stat. 1093) is repealed.
