A BILL

To amend sections of the Department of Energy Organization Act that are obsolete or inconsistent with other statutes and to repeal a related section of the Federal Energy Administration Act of 1974.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Department of Energy
5 Standardization Act of 1997”.

1 **SEC. 2. STANDARDIZATION OF DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY**
2 **REQUIREMENTS WITH GOVERNMENT-WIDE**
3 **REQUIREMENTS.**

4 (a) DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY REGULATIONS.—Sec-
5 tion 501 of the Department of Energy Organization Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 7191) is amended—

7 (1) by striking subsections (b) and (d),

8 (2) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
9 section (b) and by redesignating subsections (e), (f),
10 and (g) as subsections (c), (d), and (e), respectively,
11 and

12 (3) in subsection (c) (as so redesignated), by
13 striking “subsections (b), (c), and (d)” and inserting
14 “subsection (b)”.

15 (b) SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS AFFECTING ADVISORY
16 COMMITTEES.—

17 (1) SECTION 624.—Section 624 of the Depart-
18 ment of Energy Organization Act (42 U.S.C. 7234)
19 is amended by—

20 (A) striking “(a)”; and

21 (B) striking subsection (b).

22 (2) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMEND-
23 MENT.—Section 17 of the Federal Energy Adminis-
24 tration Act of 1974 (15 U.S.C. 776) is repealed.
