A BILL

To extend the authorization of programs under the Higher Education Act of 1965, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Higher Education
5 Amendments of 1998”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROGRAMS.**

7 (a) **EXTENSION OF PROGRAMS.**—The authorization
8 of appropriations for, and the duration of, each program
9 conducted under the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20

1 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.) shall be extended for each of the fis-
2 cal years ending before October 1, 2004.

3 (b) CONTINUATION OF AUTHORIZATION AMOUNTS.—

4 The amount authorized to be appropriated for a program
5 for each fiscal year during the period of extension under
6 subsection (a) shall be the amount authorized to be appro-
7 priated for such program for the terminal fiscal year of
8 the program.

9 (c) PERFORMANCE OF REQUIRED FUNCTIONS.—If

10 the Secretary of Education is required, in the terminal fis-
11 cal year of a program extended under subsection (a), to
12 carry out certain acts or make certain determinations that
13 are necessary for the continuation of such program, such
14 acts or determinations shall be required to be carried out
15 or made during the period of the extension under sub-
16 section (a).

17 (d) TERMINAL FISCAL YEAR.—For purposes of this
18 section, the term “terminal fiscal year”, when used with
19 respect to a program conducted under the Higher Edu-
20 cation Act of 1965, means the last fiscal year for which
21 funds are authorized to be appropriated, or during which
22 such program is authorized to be conducted, by such Act
23 as in effect on January 1, 1997.
