## AN ACT

To remove the restriction on the distribution of certain revenues from the Mineral Springs parcel to certain members of the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF RESTRICTION ON DISTRIBUTION**  
2 **OF CERTAIN REVENUES.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The fourth undesignated para-  
4 graph in section 3(b) of the Act entitled “An Act to pro-  
5 vide for the equalization of allotments on the Agua  
6 Caliente (Palm Springs) Reservation in California, and for  
7 other purposes” approved September 21, 1959 (25 U.S.C.  
8 951 et seq.), is amended by striking “east: *Provided,*” and  
9 all that follows through “deceased member.” and inserting  
10 “east.”.

11 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE AND AGREEMENT TO MAKE**  
12 **PAYMENT.**—The amendment made by subsection (a) shall  
13 apply with respect to net rents, profits, and other revenues  
14 that accrue on or after the date of distribution of the pay-  
15 ment, as provided in Tribal Ordinance 22 dated August  
16 6, 1996, to those persons referenced in Exhibit B of Tribal  
17 Ordinance 22.
