## A BILL

For the relief of Lloyd B. Gamble.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS.**

4 (a) PAYMENT.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall  
5 pay, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise ap-  
6 propriated, to Lloyd B. Gamble of Fairfax, Virginia, the  
7 sum of \$253,488.

1 (b) BASIS.—The payment required by subsection (a)  
2 shall be to compensate Lloyd B. Gamble for the injuries  
3 sustained by him as a result of the administration to him,  
4 without his knowledge, of lysergic acid diethylamide by  
5 United States Army personnel in 1957.

6 **SEC. 2. SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS.**

7 The payment made pursuant to section 1 shall be in  
8 full satisfaction of all claims Lloyd B. Gamble may have  
9 against the United States for any injury described in such  
10 section.

11 **SEC. 3. INELIGIBILITY FOR ADDITIONAL BENEFITS.**

12 Upon payment of the sum referred to in section 1,  
13 Lloyd B. Gamble shall not be eligible for any compensa-  
14 tion or benefits from the Department of Veterans Affairs  
15 or the Department of Defense for any injury described in  
16 such section.

17 **SEC. 4. LIMITATION OF AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.**

18 It shall be unlawful for an amount of more than 10  
19 percent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be  
20 paid to or received by any agent or attorney for any service  
21 rendered to Lloyd B. Gamble in connection with the bene-  
22 fits provided by this Act. Any person who violates this sec-  
23 tion shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject  
24 to a fine in the amount provided in title 18, United States  
25 Code.
