Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 478) to amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to improve the ability of individuals and local, State, and Federal agencies to comply with that Act in building, operating, maintaining, or repairing flood control projects, facilities, or structures.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 478) to amend the Endangered Spe-
3 cies Act of 1973 to improve the ability of individuals and
4 local, State, and Federal agencies to comply with that Act
5 in building, operating, maintaining, or repairing flood con-
6 trol projects, facilities, or structures. The first reading of
7 the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be
8 confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally
9 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
10 nority member of the Committee on Resources. After gen-
11 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
12 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
13 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
14 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
15 stitute recommended by the Committee on Resources now
16 printed in the bill. Each section of the committee amend-
17 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as
18 read. During consideration of the bill for amendment, the
19 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord pri-
20 ority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member
21 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the
22 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that
23 purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed
24 shall be considered as read. At the conclusion of consider-
25 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise

1 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
2 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
3 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
4 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the commit-
5 tee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The previous
6 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
7 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
8 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
9 structions.
