Mr. MCINNIS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1385) to consolidate, coordinate, and improve employment, training, literacy, and vocational rehabilitation programs in the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1385) to consolidate, coordinate,
6 and improve employment, training, literacy, and vocational

1 rehabilitation programs in the United States, and for
2 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
3 pensed with. General debate shall be confined to the bill
4 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
5 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
6 the Committee on Education and the Workforce. After
7 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
8 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
9 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
10 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
11 stitute recommended by the Committee on Education and
12 the Workforce now printed in the bill. The committee
13 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-
14 ered by division rather than by section. Each division shall
15 be considered as read. Points of order against the commit-
16 tee amendment in the nature of a substitute for failure
17 to comply with clause 5(a) of rule XXI are waived. Before
18 consideration of any other amendment it shall be in order
19 to consider the amendment numbered 1 pursuant to clause
20 6 of rule XXIII, if offered by Representative McKeon or
21 his designee. That amendment shall be considered as read,
22 may amend portions of the bill not yet read for amend-
23 ment, shall be debatable for ten minutes equally divided
24 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
25 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to

1 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
2 the Committee of the Whole. If that amendment is adopt-
3 ed, the bill, as amended, shall be considered as the original
4 bill for the purpose of further amendment. During consid-
5 eration of the bill for further amendment, the Chairman
6 of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
7 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
8 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
9 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
10 clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be
11 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of
12 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
13 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may
14 have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate
15 vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-
16 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amend-
17 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-
18 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-
19 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
20 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
21 with or without instructions.
