Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 408) to amend the Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972 to support the International Dolphin Conservation Program in the eastern tropical Pacific Ocean, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 408) to amend the Marine Mammal

1 Protection Act of 1972 to support the International Dol-  
2 phin Conservation Program in the eastern tropical Pacific  
3 Ocean, and for other purposes. The first reading of the  
4 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-  
5 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-  
6 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-  
7 ity member of the Committee on Resources. After general  
8 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under  
9 the five-minute rule. In lieu of the amendment rec-  
10 ommended by the Committee on Resources now printed  
11 in the bill, it shall be in order to consider as an original  
12 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute  
13 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute printed  
14 in the Congressional Record and numbered 1 pursuant to  
15 clause 6 of rule XXIII. That amendment shall be consid-  
16 ered as read. Points of order against that amendment for  
17 failure to comply with clause 7 of rule XVI are waived.  
18 No amendment to that amendment shall be in order except  
19 the amendment printed in the Congressional Record pur-  
20 suant to clause 6 of rule XXIII, which may be offered  
21 only by Representative Miller of California or his designee,  
22 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for one hour  
23 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an  
24 opponent, and shall not be subject to amendment. At the  
25 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the

1 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with  
2 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member  
3 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-  
4 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill  
5 or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute made  
6 in order as original text. The previous question shall be  
7 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto  
8 to final passage without intervening motion except one  
9 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
