IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Mr. HASTINGS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed.

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2203) making appropriations for energy and water development for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2203) making appropriations for

1 energy and water development for the fiscal year ending
2 September 30, 1998, and for other purposes. The first
3 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate
4 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour
5 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
6 ing minority member of the Committee on Appropriations.
7 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
8 amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order
9 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
10 clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived. During consideration
11 of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee
12 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
13 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has
14 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
15 Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule
16 XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as
17 read. The Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may:
18 (1) postpone until a time during further consideration in
19 the Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote
20 on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the
21 minimum time for electronic voting on any postponed
22 question that follows another electronic vote without inter-
23 vening business, provided that the minimum time for elec-
24 tronic voting on the first in any series of questions shall
25 be fifteen minutes. At the conclusion of consideration of

1 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
2 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may
3 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
4 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
5 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
6 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
