Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2209) making appropriations for the Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2209) making appropriations for  
6 the Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending Septem-  
7 ber 30, 1998, and for other purposes. The first reading

1 of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order against  
2 consideration of the bill for failure to comply with section  
3 302 or 308 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are  
4 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and  
5 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled  
6 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the  
7 Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the  
8 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
9 minute rule and shall be considered as read. Points of  
10 order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply  
11 with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived. No amendment  
12 shall be in order except those printed in the report of the  
13 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each  
14 amendment may be considered only in the order printed  
15 in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated  
16 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-  
17 able for the time specified in the report equally divided  
18 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall  
19 not be subject to amendment except as specified in the  
20 report, and shall not be subject to a demand for division  
21 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the  
22 Whole. All points of order against amendments printed in  
23 the report are waived. The Chairman of the Committee  
24 of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further  
25 consideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for

1 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five  
2 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any  
3 postponed question that follows another electronic vote  
4 without intervening business: *Provided*, That the minimum  
5 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-  
6 tions shall be fifteen minutes. At the conclusion of consid-  
7 eration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
8 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
9 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall  
10 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments  
11 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except  
12 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
