RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 107) expressing the sense of the Congress that the award of attorneys' fees, costs, and sanctions of \$285,864.78 ordered by United States District Judge Royce C. Lamberth on December 18, 1997, should not be paid with taxpayer funds.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
2 ation of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 107) expressing
3 the sense of the Congress that the award of attorneys'
4 fees, costs, and sanctions of \$285,864.78 ordered by
5 United States District Judge Royce C. Lamberth on De-
6 cember 18, 1997, should not be paid with taxpayer funds.
7 The first reading of the joint resolution shall be dispensed
8 with. General debate shall be confined to the joint resolu-
9 tion and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
10 trolled by Representative Hayworth of Arizona or his des-
11 ignee and Representative Stark of California or his des-
12 ignee. After general debate the joint resolution shall be
13 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The
14 joint resolution shall be considered as read. The Chairman
15 of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until
16 a time during further consideration in the Committee of
17 the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amend-
18 ment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time
19 for electronic voting on any postponed question that fol-
20 lows another electronic vote without intervening business,
21 provided that the minimum time for electronic voting on
22 the first in any series of questions shall be fifteen minutes.
23 At the conclusion of consideration of the joint resolution
24 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
25 joint resolution to the House with such amendments as

1 may have been adopted. The previous question shall be
2 considered as ordered on the joint resolution and amend-
3 ments thereto to final passage without intervening motion
4 except one motion to recommit with or without instruc-
5 tions.
