Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2400) to authorize funds for Federal-aid highways, highway safety programs, and transit programs, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2400) to authorize funds for Fed-  
6 eral-aid highways, highway safety programs, and transit  
7 programs, and for other purposes. The first reading of the

1 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against  
2 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall  
3 be confined to the bill and the amendments made in order  
4 by this resolution and shall not exceed two hours and 30  
5 minutes, with two hours equally divided and controlled by  
6 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-  
7 mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure and 30 min-  
8 utes equally divided and controlled by the chairman and  
9 ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and  
10 Means. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
11 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in  
12 order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of  
13 amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in  
14 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee  
15 on Transportation and Infrastructure now printed in the  
16 bill, modified by the amendment recommended by the  
17 Committee on Ways and Means now printed in the bill  
18 and the amendment printed in part 1 of the report of the  
19 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. That  
20 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-  
21 ered as read. All points of order against that amendment  
22 in the nature of a substitute are waived. No amendment  
23 to that amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be  
24 in order except those printed in part 2 of the report of  
25 the Committee on Rules. Each amendment may be offered

1 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered  
2 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be con-  
3 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the first time speci-  
4 fied in the report equally divided and controlled by the  
5 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-  
6 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division  
7 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the  
8 Whole. All points of order against the amendments printed  
9 in the report are waived. The chairman of the Committee  
10 of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further  
11 consideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for  
12 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five  
13 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any  
14 postponed question that follows another electronic vote  
15 without intervening business, provided that the minimum  
16 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-  
17 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-  
18 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
19 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
20 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a  
21 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted  
22 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amend-  
23 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-  
24 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
25 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage

- 1 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
- 2 with or without instructions.
