## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 285) expressing the sense of the Congress that the President of the United States should reconsider his decision to be formally received in Tiananmen Square by the Government of the People's Republic of China.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the resolution  
3 (H. Con. Res. 285) expressing the sense of the Congress  
4 that the President of the United States should reconsider  
5 his decision to be formally received in Tiananmen Square

1 by the Government of the People's Republic of China. The  
2 resolution shall be considered as read for amendment. The  
3 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the  
4 resolution to final adoption without intervening motion ex-  
5 cept: (1) one hour of debate on the resolution equally di-  
6 vided and controlled by the Majority Leader or his des-  
7 ignee and a Member opposed to the resolution; and (2)  
8 one motion to recommit.
