## RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 3267) to direct the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Bureau of Reclamation, to conduct a feasibility study and construct a project to reclaim the Salton Sea.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3267) to  
4 direct the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the  
5 Bureau of Reclamation, to conduct a feasibility study and  
6 construct a project to reclaim the Salton Sea. The bill

1 shall be considered as read for amendment. In lieu of the  
2 amendment recommended by the Committee on Resources  
3 now printed in the bill, the amendment in the nature of  
4 a substitute printed in the report of the Committee on  
5 Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered as  
6 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
7 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-  
8 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion  
9 except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill, as amended,  
10 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-  
11 ing minority member of the Committee on Resources; (2)  
12 a further amendment printed in the Congressional Record  
13 pursuant to clause 6 of rule XXIII, if offered by Rep-  
14 resentative Miller of California or his designee, which may  
15 be considered notwithstanding the adoption of the amend-  
16 ment in the nature of a substitute printed in the report  
17 of the Committee on Rules, shall be considered as read,  
18 and shall be separately debatable for one hour equally di-  
19 vided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent;  
20 and (3) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-  
21 tions.
