RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 1132) to modify the boundaries of the Bandelier National Monument to include the lands within the headwaters of the Upper Alamo Watershed which drain into the Monument and which are not currently within the jurisdiction of a Federal land management agency, to authorize purchase or donation of those lands, and for other purposes, and for consideration of the bill (S. 2133) an act to preserve the cultural resources of the Route 66 corridor and to

authorize the Secretary of the Interior to provide assistance.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (S. 1132) to modify
4 the boundaries of the Bandelier National Monument to in-
5 clude the lands within the headwaters of the Upper Alamo
6 Watershed which drain into the Monument and which are
7 not currently within the jurisdiction of a Federal land
8 management agency, to authorize purchase or donation of
9 those lands, and for other purposes. The bill shall be con-
10 sidered as read for amendment. The previous question
11 shall be considered as ordered on the bill to final passage
12 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
13 on the bill equally divided and controlled by the chairman
14 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Re-
15 sources; and (2) one motion to recommit.

16 SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
17 be in order without intervention of any point of order to
18 consider in the House the bill (S. 2133) an act to preserve
19 the cultural resources of the Route 66 corridor and to au-
20 thorize the Secretary of the Interior to provide assistance.
21 The bill shall be considered as read for amendment. The
22 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
23 bill to final passage without intervening motion except: (1)
24 one hour of debate on the bill equally divided and con-

1 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
2 the Committee on Resources; and (2) one motion to re-
3 commit.
