CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, June 28, 2001, or Friday, June 29,
4 2001, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
5 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand

1 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, July 10, 2001, or until
2 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-
3 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
4 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses
5 or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, June
6 28, 2001, Friday, June 29, 2001, Saturday, June 30,
7 2001, Monday, July 2, 2001, Tuesday, July 3, 2001,
8 Thursday, July 5, 2001, Friday, July 6, 2001, or Satur-
9 day, July 7, 2001, on a motion offered pursuant to this
10 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
11 ignee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Mon-
12 day, July 9, 2001, or until such time on that day as may
13 be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee in the
14 motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second
15 day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
16 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
17 first.

18 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
19 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
20 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
21 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
22 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
23 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
