CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the sine die adjournment of the first session
of the One Hundred Seventh Congress.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, December 20, 2001, or Friday, De-
4 cember 21, 2001, on a motion offered pursuant to this
5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his

1 designee, it stand adjourned sine die, or until Members
2 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this
3 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that
4 when the Senate adjourns at the close of business on
5 Thursday, December 20, 2001, or Friday, December 21,
6 2001, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
7 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
8 adjourned sine die, or until Members are notified to reas-
9 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
10 whichever occurs first.

11 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
12 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
13 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
14 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
15 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble at such place
16 and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion,
17 the public interest shall warrant it.
