Mr. SAXTON submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was
considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of
Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment
of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Wednesday, February 14, 2001, it stand ad-
4 journed until 2 p.m. on Monday, February 26, 2001, and
5 that when the House adjourns on Monday, February 26,
6 2001, it stand adjourned until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday,
7 February 27, 2001, for morning-hour debate, or until
8 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-
9 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
10 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses

1 or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, Feb-
2 ruary 15, 2001, or Friday, February 16, 2001, on a mo-
3 tion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its
4 Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or ad-
5 journed until noon on Monday, February 26, 2001, or
6 until such time on that day as may be specified by its
7 Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
8 or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after Members
9 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this
10 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

11 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
12 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
13 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
14 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
15 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
16 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
