Authorizing the printing as a House document of a collection of memorial tributes made in honor of the late Gerald Solomon.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZING PRINTING OF COLLECTION OF**  
4                    **STATEMENTS IN TRIBUTE TO GERALD SOL-**  
5                    **OMON.**

6        A collection of statements made in tribute to the late  
7 Gerald Solomon, together with related materials, shall be

1 printed as a House document under the direction of the  
2 Joint Committee on Printing, with illustrations and suit-  
3 able binding.

4 **SEC. 2. NUMBER OF COPIES.**

5 The number of copies of the document printed under  
6 section 1 shall be the lesser of—

7 (1) 114 casebound copies, of which 50 copies  
8 shall be provided to the family of the late Gerald  
9 Solomon, 1 copy shall be provided to each Senator  
10 from the State of New York, and 2 copies shall be  
11 provided to each Member of the House of Represent-  
12 atives from the State of New York; or

13 (2) such number of casebound copies as does  
14 not exceed a total production and printing cost of  
15 \$25,525, with distribution to be allocated in the  
16 same proportion as described in paragraph (1).
